1. **Cover Letter/Letter of Intent**, including brief bio, academic goals, description of Estonian heritage and any involvement in the Estonian community

3. **Short Essay:** What does being Estonian mean to you? Why is it important? (maximum 500 words)
4. Curriculum Vitae
5. 2 Letters from Character references, one from the Estonian community, if possible
6. Digital photo/Head shot
7. Proof of registration

Who is eligible:

- Canadian permanent residents or citizens
- Registered in 2nd year or above at a Canadian or Estonian university/college
- Has not previously received an EFC scholarship for this level/program of study

Guidelines:

Submit completed application form and all accompanying documents, in English or Estonian, to EFC Office or info@estonianfoundation.ca on or by October 15.

If successful, scholarship applicants agree:

- To provide SIN number and proof of Canadian residence (e.g. driver's licence)
- To be contacted by EFC, and to provide EFC with updated address information
- To attend the EFC AGM, or send a representative
- To the publication of their names, photos, and any written information submitted in conjunction with their application by EFC on website or in other promotional materials
